When I pray, sometimes I ask for help, sometimes I ask for mercy and grace and sometimes I even ask for a miracle. And there is nothing wrong with these requests, but I am learning that what I really need to ask for first is just to know Him. I should seek to know him intimately and deeply. And the reason is simply this. When I seek God first, I seem to get everything else. There are many promises in the Bible about those who seek Him. Here are a few to consider.

- 1. If my people who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face, then I will hear from Heaven. 2 Chronicles: 7-14*
- 2. I love those who love me, and those who seek me, find me. Proverbs 8:17*
- 3. Anyone who comes to Him must believe he exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek him. Hebrews 11:6*

The main point of this is that we need to seek Him and not just His blessing. It is then that you will find joy by simply knowing Him better. You will also begin to see that that you will be satisfied with what God thinks is best for you, whether you get what you think is best for you or not. When you are going through tough times, seek God first, even more than you seek deliverance from your circumstances.

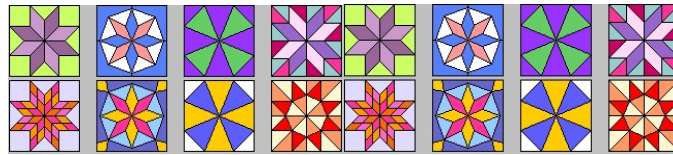

Kids' Church

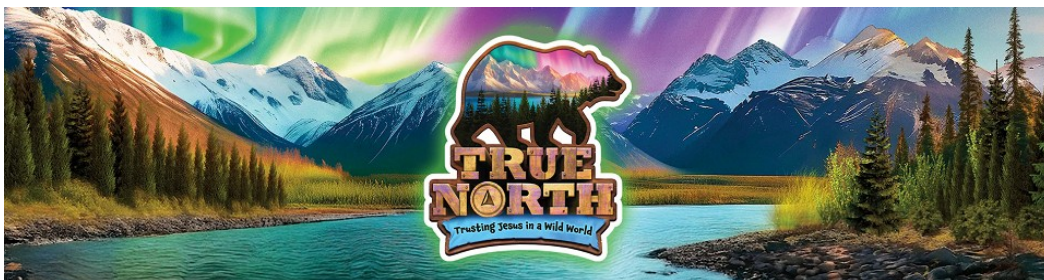
